- Arrive to class on time and prepared.
- Follow appropriate dress code for all classes and rehearsals. Jazz, Modern, Contemporary, Acro, and Hip Hop students should wear long pants or tights so that floors are protected from oils and sweat.
- Dispose of trash in the trashcans. Empty liquids into the sink in the kitchen area before putting the containers in the trashcans.
- Refrain from all running and shouting inside of the dance school.
- CBS Staff only may enter the office area unless permission is given otherwise.
- Wear dance shoes or remove street shoes before entering the studio.
- Wear dance shoes indoors only.
- Store dance bags and other items in the cubbies provided.
- Obtain permission from instructors before photographing or videoing inside the studio.
- Use respectful and acceptable language at all times.
- Wait inside of the building for your ride to arrive.
